Letter from Pastor Steve On January 26th, Shelter Rock Church members will have the opportunity to vote for a new Senior Pastor.

Twenty-five years ago, when the church I was at in Illinois was discussing whether or not the church should bring on a thirty-five year old pastor, just finishing seminary, somebody said, "Let's pray about it," and that is what we did. When voted in to my first pastoral position, I was so grateful that my new role was built upon a foundation of prayer. Fast-forward and the Lord placed on my heart the importance of making room for younger leadership and the same conviction that we need to pray.

We need to pray that Pastor Henry will be "strong and courageous!" This is the very prayer of Moses for Joshua. When Moses said these words his ministry was not done, but the Lord prepared him to make room for the new leader. He gave these words: "The LORD himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged" (Deut. 31:8).

So like Moses, we need to pray these words of encouragement over Pastor Henry. We need to pray for me, as I transition to a new season of ministry, that the Lord will give me maximum effectiveness to advance His kingdom, and we also need to pray for Shelter Rock Church. This church belongs to Jesus our Lord and it is our desire that we will always be soft clay in the Master's hands. So together we pray.



What is Prayer?

"Prayer does not fit us for the greater work; prayer is the greater work." Oswald Chambers "While Peter was speaking, a cloud appeared and covered them, and they were afraid as they entered the cloud. A voice came from the cloud, saying, "This

is my Son, whom I have chosen; **listen to him.**" When the voice had spoken, they found that Jesus was alone. The disciples kept this to themselves and did not tell anyone at that time what they had seen."

-Luke 9:34-36

It has been said that nothing of eternal significance happens without prayer. It is with this in mind that we embark on these 21 days of prayer together. But what is prayer? And what are we hoping to accomplish by spending so much time in prayer?

Prayer, if I could define it so simply, is conversation with God. And as is true of any conversation, prayer requires that we not only speak to God, but that we hear from Him and listen to Him.

Over the course of these 21 days, let us devote ourselves to hearing from God. We will sit with Him and be with Him. We will make our desires known to God, but more importantly, we will ask for God's desires to be made known to us. We will aim to listen to God's voice and discern God's will both for our church and for our lives. We will commune with Him in prayer, trusting Him "to do immeasurably more than we could ever ask or imagine" (Eph. 3:20).

What is Fasting?

"Fasting confirms our utter dependence upon God by finding in Him a source of sustenance beyond food." Dallas Willard "When you fast, do not look somber as the hypocrites do...But when you fast, put oil on your head and wash your face, so that it will not be obvious to others that you are fasting, but only to your Father, who is unseen; and your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you." -Matthew 6:16-18

Notice Jesus doesn't say *"if* you fast." He says, *"when* you fast." There is an expectation that fasting is a spiritual discipline to be practiced with regularity.

But let's not confuse regularity with religiosity or legalism. We are not fasting to earn God's grace or love. But because God has saved us, He has given us spiritual disciplines to practice that are powerful, beneficial tools. Even Jesus availed Himself of the tool of fasting. But why is it so important? How does it work? What might be the value of fasting?

Consider the following:

- Fasting helps to put our carnal nature under subjection. It helps to get us out of the way. It diminishes selfishness.
- Fasting humbles us. It positions us to receive God's grace. God gives grace to the humble, and grace flows downhill.
- Fasting intensifies our prayer life by helping us to focus on God and depend on Him more acutely.
- Fasting strengthens our faith by fine-tuning our spiritual ears to hear God's voice and words.
