Important Missions Information

Read This BEFORE YOU APPLY!

Dear Prospective Trip Participant,

I am so excited you are considering going on one of our short-term missions trips! I know of no better way for you to see how God can use you to impact the life of someone else, and for you to see the world as God sees it, than by going on a missions trip to serve others. Here are the **STEPS YOU SHOULD TAKE:**



- 1. Pray Ask God if He wants you to go and serve Him on a mission trip this summer.
- 2. Discuss Share your desire to go on a mission trip with your family and other important people in your life. Ask them for their prayers and counsel.
- 3. Contact Send an e-mail to the Contact for your trip to express your interest in the trip and to discuss your possible involvement.
- 4. Apply If the Contact agrees that the trip is a possibility for you, go to <u>ShelterRockChurch.com/missions</u> and download the Application for the trip you are interested in. Be sure to read the information carefully to understand the significant commitment you are making, not just for the trip, but also the training schedule before the trip. If you feel you can commit to the trip requirements, complete the Application and hand it in along with your Non-Refundable Deposit.
- 5. Get Your Shots & Passport If you're going on an international trip, these are a must. Don't hesitate! These things can take time. If you have a passport, <u>be</u> sure it does not expire within 6 months from the end of trip.
- 6. Raise Support Write your support letter and send it to your friends and family, inviting them to participate in your faith adventure.
- 7. Work Hard Mission trips don't just happen during the week you're gone. They take a lot of work, commitment, and sacrifice in the months leading up to them. This will include team meetings, training, fundraisers, etc.
- 8. Journal As soon as you are accepted onto the team, begin writing about your experiences the team-building meetings, how God is providing, your prayers, etc.
- 9. Go You've prayed. You've taken a step of faith. You've prepared. God has provided. Now it's time to go!
- 10.Tell When you return, be sure to tell others what God did during your mission experience.
- 11. Thank Be sure to say a special *Thank You!* to those who supported you in prayer and financially. Send them a report of your trip along with some pictures.

Missions Trip Requirements

- 1. All participants must meet the age requirements listed for the particular trip.
- 2. All participants must actively attend a local church.
- 3. All participants must be regular attenders at SRC Student Ministries for at least 3 months prior to trip dates. That means being at at least 3 of our regular gatherings a month Sunday mornings, Youth Night, or Delta Small Groups (not just events).
- 4. All participants must attend all practices & meetings established for the team. These dates are communicated on the <u>Trip Information Sheet which must be signed and approved before being accepted onto the team</u>.
- 5. All participants must be committed living and growing as disciples of Jesus Christ.
- 6. All participants must commit to praying daily for the trip—the team, travel, provision, the country, the local churches we will be partnering with, the people we will be ministering to, the missionaries, etc.
- 7. All participants must secure a personal intercessory prayer team of at least 7 people who will pray for them and the team during both the training and travel phases of the trip.
- 8. All participants must meet the financial deadlines listed for the trip.
- 9. All participants must secure the proper documentation for the trip (i.e. passports, visas, letters of consent, etc.). These requirements vary according to trip. Once approved for the trip, immediately begin applying for Passports/Visas, etc. as these take time to receive. (IMPORTANT: If you have a passport, be sure that the expiration date is not within 6 months of return. Example: Trip July 1-10, passport must be valid at least through January 11 of the following year.)
- 10. All participants must receive the necessary immunizations. These requirements vary according to trip. **Tetanus** shot is mandatory for all trips.
- 11. All participants must submit to and abide by the rules and guidelines established by the team leader(s).

Finances

- 1. When it comes to funds, we want everyone to think TEAM. While each person is responsible to raise the cost of the trip, we are all in this together.
- 2. The cost will include all transportation, accommodations and group meal expenses for the duration of the trip unless otherwise specified. Additional funds for personal spending are the responsibility of the individual. The cost of passports, visas, immunizations and other preparations for the trip are the responsibility of the individual. All individuals are required to adhere to the Personal Fund Raising Guidelines below.
- 3. Trip costs are quoted based on estimated airfares and may be adjusted up or down when actual rates are confirmed.
- 4. In order to adhere to IRS standards, ALL donated funds that come in go toward the trip and the team as a whole, NOT to individual participants. So long as the below guidelines are followed, we do honor the request of donors for funds to go toward an individual's trip, however, once full support has been raised, the additional monies raised go toward the trip as a whole and to support other team members. Due to IRS regulations, we are not allowed to hold these funds for a person's future missions trips. Nor are these funds allowed to be re-designated by you for other purposes within the church.
- 5. Contributions to the trip are tax-deductible and non-refundable. In the event a student cancels participation, funds will go directly to the trip they were going to go on.

- 6. If you wish to personally assign funds to a specific participant with the option of reimbursement should the person not be able to participate (less deposit and funds already spent on the individual's behalf), the funds will be accepted as a **payment**, NOT as a tax-deductible contribution.
- 7. Any unpaid balance of trip expenses is the responsibility of the participant and is expected to be paid prior to the departure of the team. If a participant decides to cancel his/her participation in the mission trip, he/she will be responsible for any prepaid expenses which cannot be refunded (i.e. airfare, lost deposits, visas, etc.)

Personal Fund Raising:

Individuals who feel called by God to participate in a short-term missions trip are responsible for raising the necessary funds to cover expenses for their trip. When you make a deposit on a trip, or when money is first received for you, we will begin tracking your contributions. You and others may make periodic contributions at any time. All checks should be made out to *Shelter Rock Church*. It is very important that all contributions be clearly designated for the trip. However, DO NOT PUT THIS INFORMATION ON YOUR CHECK! Instead, please write it on the envelope or on a slip of paper included with the check. Checks with individual names on them are NOT acceptable as tax-deductible.





Support Raising Guidelines:

- 1. Prayer Team. Even more important than raising financial support for your trip is raising a personal prayer team. You are asked to recruit 7 people who will pray for the team as a whole, as well as for you personally while you are preparing to go on your trip as well as while you are there. Begin recruiting these people right away so that they can pray for you as you raise the necessary funds and make other preparations for the trip. The team leader will provide you with information to pass on to your prayer team, such as blog address.
- 2. Support Letter. Participants are encouraged to write a support letter. A sample letter is attached. This letter should be sent to family and friends and should be sent as soon as you are accepted for the trip. Note: We suggest that you consider sending your support letters primarily to your friends and family members outside the church, and limit letters given to people within the church to those you are especially close to personally. The reason for this suggestion is that we want to make sure that our church members are not overwhelmed by a large number of support letters. The people within the church will have other opportunities to support the team as a whole in various ways, e.g. group fundraisers. You are encouraged to solicit people from the church for your prayer team.
- 3. Personal Fund Raisers. Another way you can enlist people's financial support is through personal fund raisers. Think of creative things you can do personally to meet people's

needs. In return simply ask that they make a financial contribution toward your trip. Examples: Baking cookies, cutting grass, raking leaves, shoveling snow, cleaning houses, babysitting, pet-sitting, house-sitting, plant-sitting, couch-sitting, or really, any kind of sitting, because apparently people like to give money to people who sit on things, etc. All checks should be made out to *Shelter Rock Church*. It is very important that all contributions be clearly designated with your name and the name of the trip so that the funds can be properly tracked. However, DO NOT PUT THIS INFORMATION ON YOUR CHECK! Instead, please put it on the envelope. Checks with individual names on them are not acceptable as tax-deductible.

4. Group Fundraisers. Depending on the need, group fundraisers may be used to raise money for the trips. Group Fundraisers will be used to decrease the cost for those team members who participate in the group fund raiser. We want to encourage financial responsibility, and not foster an atmosphere wherein you simply rely on other group members to raise funds for you. Please consider the reality that if we raise \$1,000 but have 20 people participate, that means each person gets \$50. The point is, group fundraisers will help some, but don't bank on them bringing in a majority of your trip cost.
