








Draw Near

## Luke 6:27-31

27 "But to you who are listening I say: Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, 28 bless those who curse you, <u>pray for</u> those who mistreat you. 29 If someone slaps you on one cheek, furn to them the other also. If someone takes your coat, do not withhold your shirt from them. 30 Give to everyoné who asks you, and if anyone takes what belongs to you, do not demand it back. 31 Do to others as you would have them do TO YOU.

Matthew 5:43-44


43 "You have heard that it was said, 'Love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' 44 But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you
