- 1. Balance, Completed Permission Slips, and copy of Insurance Card <u>due by Sunday, December 31, 2017.</u>
- 2. Tuscarora must be notified of any <u>Medically Necessary</u> Diet Restrictions before our arrival. The *Special Diet* form is available on our website with the registration form, and should be <u>sent to Tuscarora directly</u>.
- 3. Students who us inhalers/EPI pens/etc. must show them to our camp nurse at drop off at SRC. They will not be allowed to attend without them.
- Departure: All students need to be at Shelter Rock Church Manhasset
 626 Plandome Rd. by 3:30pm on Friday, January 5th to sign in and load the busses.
- Please <u>bring a brown bag dinner</u> for the bus ride Friday evening. This will save us time and get us to Tuscarora on time.
- 6. **Pickup**: Approximately 5pm on Sunday, January 7th at Shelter Rock Church Manhasset. We will have students call home when we are nearing the city with our Estimated Time of Arrival.

Packing List

- 1. You should bring some extra money for the following things:
 - Food on the way to or on the way home fro Tuscarora (if your group is stopping)
 - Snack Shop during free time.
 - WF Merchandise (Sweatshirts (\$24-30), CDs from our musical guests, books by our speaker, etc.)
- 2. What to **Bring**:
 - a. Sleeping bag & Pillow (Bring in a case or garbage bag with your name on it.)
 - b. Plastic garbage bags for wet clothes (in case of snow or rain)
 - c. Warm and modest clothes for two days
 - d. Clothes for outdoor activities as the weather permits (gloves, hats, etc.)

 - c. Drugs, alcohol, tobacco, vape pens (or similar), or illegal substances
 - d. Weapons

4. Cell phones are allowed on the trip, **but no headphones or**

earbuds (we want students to talk to each other), and we respectfully request that they not be texting or calling home or friends during the weekend. We want them to maximize their time on the weekend to have a meaningful encounter Jesus, to make friends, and to deepen their relationships with students also on the retreat. If students are found to be spending too much time on their phones, leaders are instructed to talk to them and redirect them to engaging in the weekend.
