

Poor in Spirit

Key to all other Beatitudes

Essential to enter Kingdom of God



Poor in Spirit

Acknowledge spiritual bankruptcy

Confess your unworthiness before God

Place your utter dependence on God

12 Steps of AA

- 1. We admit we are powerless over alcohol and that our lives had become unmanageable.
- 2. We came to believe that a Power greater than ourselves could restore us to sanity.
- 3. We made a decision to turn our will and our lives over to the care of God as we understood Him.

Poor in Spirit Is:

Absence of pride

Awareness of being nothing before God

Not relying on self or personal resources

Submitting to God – Utter dependence on God
