Or Interpret present circumstances by what you know about God

When Pain/Loss Comes...

What am I supposed to do?

Who knows your pain and sorrow

No answers or understanding

Going somewhere? Go->God

Seek God -- Who Knows Best?

Shift focus from self -> God

Draw near to God....
